FROM THE BOARD...

CALENDAR: No April calendar is attached this month because all group activities have indefinitely been suspended at the Community Center until the Covid-19 crisis passes. We are hoping the upcoming events listed below under "Save The Date" will occur as planned, but if we are unable to hold the events, we will promptly inform everyone.

BIRCH TREE REPLACEMENTS UPDATE: Our Manager, Jim Armstrong, and the Board have received some further information regarding replacement of the birch trees. When we remove the birch trees, we will plant the replacements at the same time with as little disruption and disturbance to other bushes and plants as possible. We learned that a couple of the original replacement choices may not be the best choices, and we have modified the list of four choices to now include 1) a White Rhododendron; 2) a Lavender Rhododendron; 3) a Cusa Dogwood; and 4) a Japanese Maple (see attached pictures). Larger photocopies of these choices are also available at the office. Because the choices have changed, we are asking every homeowner who has a Birch tree to resubmit a Communications Worksheet to the office indicating 1) whether or not you want your Birch tree removed; and 2) what replacement choice you want, if it is removed. The deadline for notifying the office by completing a Communications Worksheet is Wednesday, April 15.

If you decide to keep your Birch tree, please complete and submit a Variance Form indicating 1) you plan to keep your Birch tree; and 2) you will be responsible for maintaining the tree. The completed Variance Form will be retained in your office file as a recorded acknowledgement that any future owners must also accept responsibility for maintaining the tree.

If you have any further questions, please contact our Manager, Jim Armstrong, for clarification.
