We are starting to receive complaints again about speeding and people not stopping at stop signs. The simple solution would be for everyone to stop at the signs, but that doesn't seem to work. We don't want to make everyone suffer by installing speed bumps once again, so we are looking for ways to enforce the rules. One way would be to install cameras and then assess fines against violators. Sometimes it seems like the only way to get peoples' attention is when it costs them money.

THE PONDS AND YOUR FISH: All four of the ponds were stocked with fish on May 12. These fish love to eat fish pellets. Any resident or fisherman who wants larger fish or enjoys seeing them up close may feed the fish pellets at the ponds' edges. The stocking included bass, bluegills, hybrid bluegill, perch, minnows and amurs. The amurs will start to eat algae and grass clippings as soon as the water gets warmer. The minnows will feed all the larger fish until they are gone. Then, if fish pellets are not added, the nature pond environment will feed the fish. The larger bass will feed on all of the smaller fish.

The fishing should be good this year and even better in the future. Remember:

- Use barbless hooks only;
- Release all fish immediately after catching them;
- Fishing is limited to unit owners and guests. (It would be a good idea to accompany all guests);
- Non-owners and non-guests should be asked to leave. (The easiest way to be sure is to ask where the fisherman lives); and
- All children must be accompanied by an adult.
