# FROM THE BOARD...

OPENING COMMUNITY CENTER: On October 8<sup>th</sup> the Community Center reopened to all Pine Ridge residents and their guests. The Board, however, does not recommend using the facility at this time due to the possible presence of the Covid-19 virus and, if you do use the facility, you will be doing so at your own risk. Per Ohio Health Department recommendations and the Stay Safe Ohio Order, the following rules/regulations are posted on warning signs throughout the Center:

- If you do not feel well or are sick, entry into the Center is prohibited.
- The use of social distancing and maintaining at least 6 feet or more between individuals from different households everywhere in the Center is required.
- After the use of any equipment or machines, the item must be wiped down and sanitized. Sanitation products and wipes are available in the exercise area, bathrooms and main kitchen/dining room area.
- Loitering in the Center is prohibited.
- For the safety and protection of your fellow neighbors, you are asked to wear a face covering when interacting in close proximity of others. Please also practice good hygiene, including washing hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, using hand sanitizer, refraining from touching eyes, nose and mouth with unwashed hands, and coughing/sneezing into your elbow.

Monika is also now accepting Center reservation requests, but the reservation cannot be for more than a maximum of 10 people. For the time being, we will not be scheduling other social activities or Board meetings where it is likely more than 10 individuals will be present.

**2021 BUDGET:** The Board is currently working on completing the 2021 Budget and we anticipate mailing out the new budget and updated 2021 monthly condo fees information by mid-November.

<u>DOGWOOD TREES</u>: If you are an owner who had a dogwood tree planted in your front yard earlier this year, please leave the tree alone. Many of the dogwoods appear to have died, but

Jim Armstrong is continuing to monitor them and they are under a one-year warranty. If they need to be replaced in the Spring, we will evaluate them then.
