Some residents have expressed concerns about Association dues and why there are differences in cost by unit. The developers used information like square footage, landscape package, repair and maintenance costs, among others to establish a PAR RATE. This is unique to each unit. Unit owners pay dues according to these factors.

A large project addressing street repairs and drainage issues was just successfully completed and is leading the way for more to come this Spring and year ahead. Carl has planned out most of the remaining repairs and will begin shortly. We aim to solve as many of these issues as possible within budget this year.

We have a policy that any outside contractor provide proof of insurance and bond before any work is completed. A few occasions have had an owner do this work and cause damage to their property and even leaks inside their unit.
