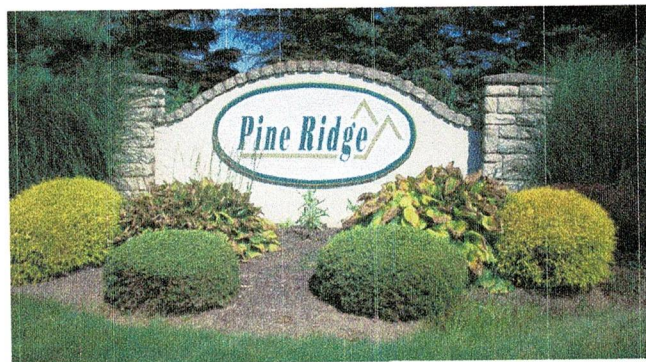

We have a new maintenance program offered by the Association to provide Dryer Vent Cleanouts.
