Strasburg-Franklin Local Schools Acknowledgment and Waiver to Use "The Mac" Fitness Facility

In exchange for the Strasburg-Franklin Local School District Board of Education ("Board") allowing Participant to access and use the Board's exercise and weight room facilities known as "The Mac" located at 140 North Bodmer Avenue, Strasburg, OH 44680 (the "Facilities"), as well as the equipment within the Facilities, the Participant agrees as follows:

- 1. The Participant personally, and on behalf of their heirs, assigns, executors, and spouses, agrees to hold harmless and indemnify the Board and its individual members, officers, employees, representatives, and agents from any and all liability arising from negligence or from any other cause, and from all damages to person or property, of any kind whatsoever, including but not limited to death, bodily, personal or mental injury, arising directly or indirectly from my use of the Facilities or the equipment therein or from Participant's presence otherwise in or on the Facilities' premises, without limitation;
 - a) If Participant is an officer, employee, or agent of the Board, the Participant acknowledges and agrees that they are accessing and using the Facilities as a member to the public and not arising out of or in the course of their employment and thus waives Participant's right to worker's compensation.
- 2. The Participant acknowledges and agrees that it is their sole responsibility to evaluate carefully the risks in using the Facilities and the equipment therein, and the dangers posed by the willful, negligent or other conduct of the Participant or others using the Facilities or the equipment therein, and Participant voluntarily assumes full responsibility for, and all risk of, any and all damages to person or property of any kind whatsoever, including but not limited to death, bodily, personal or mental injury, without limitation;
- 3. Participant shall not sue the Board or its individual members, employees, or agents for actions or omissions arising from the use of or presence at the Facilities:
- 4. Participant agrees to abide by all Board policies in addition to adhering to the rules and procedures governing the use of the Facilities, which includes:
 - a. Access is limited to before school, after school, and weekends in the afternoon. Hours open to the public will be posted on the door, school entrance, and/or website.
 - b. Participant shall not bring any guests, current students, or minors to the Facilities.
 - c. Participant shall take proper care of the facilities and equipment.
 - d. Participant shall use courteous and appropriate behavior at all times.

- e. During busy times or when people are waiting, Participant shall share the equipment.
- f. Appropriate workout attire is required. No swimsuits or clothing that may be inappropriate in a school environment is allowed.
- g. Participant shall observe proper regular hygiene and clean equipment as needed.
- h. Participant shall report a malfunction of equipment to a Board staff member.
- i. No food or gum is permitted in the Facilities.
- Participant shall not use Facilities to promote or sell any services (e.g., personal training services).
- Participant shall be responsible for any damage they cause to the Facilities over and above ordinary wear;
- 6. Participant represents and warrants that they are of suitable health to exercise, they are not prohibited from exercising in any manner by a doctor, and do not know of any reason why they should not exercise;
- 7. Participant acknowledges there is no attendant on site.
- Participant acknowledges and agrees that the Board may contact the emergency contact identified below and will keep the contact updated;
- 9. Participant certifies that they have adequate health insurance;
- 10. Participant agrees the Board, in its sole discretion, may suspend or discontinue their use of the Facilities at any time, including for violations of any of the rules identified above or the terms of this agreement; and
- 11. Participant agrees that if any portion of this document is held invalid, the remaining provisions shall be binding and continue in full force and effect.
