REMINDER RE CLEANING UP WASTE ON WALKING TRAILS: Once again the Board has been notified about numerous locations throughout Pine Ridge walking trails where dog owners have failed to pick up their dog's waste, chew has been spat out on the trails, and even banana peels have been thrown away on the trails. These offenses may not always be done by Pine Ridge residents, but perhaps by outside walkers. The form info will be kept anonymous, but it may help us re contacting the offender directly and addressing the issue.

ASSISTING INJURED ANIMALS ON PINE RIDGE PROPERTY: If you discover an injured animal in your yard, driveway or anywhere on Pine Ridge common grounds, the following information may assist you in getting help for the animal or having it removed.

- 1) The Ohio Department of Natural Resources/Wildlife Section at 1-800-762-2437 may assist in providing you with potential rehabilitators.
- 2) Two close rehab facilities are the Stark Park Wildlife Conservation Center at 330-477-0448 in Massillon and the Cloverleaf Wildlife Center at 330-499-5788 in North Canton.
- 3) The New Philadelphia Wildlife Control at 740-263-2129 can assist with the removal of nuisance animals.
